We started with one Nursery and two Reception classes and then expanded to include a mixed Year 1 and 2 class. So, it is really exciting to have almost doubled in size and to now include KS2.

Introduction

Bearsted Primary Academy, which opened in September 2020, became the latest addition to the highly successful Leigh Academies Trust (LAT), whose mission is to shape lives and transform communities, providing an education which nurtures and cares for all learners in order for them to achieve excellence and to create confident children with high levels of resilience and integrity, preparing them for their future.

As a brand new school we look forward to welcoming two new reception classes of up to 30 pupils per class, to join our current Reception cohort, totalling 120 pupils. Each year we will continue to grow our academy with two reception classes until we reach full capacity of 420 pupils across Years R-6 in September 2026.

In addition to our academy we have our own nursery, Little Bears, for children between the ages of 3-5 years which can take up to 26 pupils per session.

From their first day of school we will prepare our children for the next stage in their lives by focusing on delivering our Key Principles:

- Developing independence
- Creating collaborative learning experiences
- Encouraging risk-taking
- Promoting self-belief
- Developing strong communication skills
- Ensuring academic achievement

In order to provide facilities and support for our families we provide 'wrap around care' which includes an academy led breakfast club and after school supervised care for our working parents. This is in addition to our full programme of extra-curricular enrichment clubs.

We believe in building strong partnerships with parents and carers, working closely together to ensure all of our learners succeed. We take pride in developing positive working relationships, not only between pupils and teachers, but also between the academy and home in order to achieve our aspirational values and vision.



At Bearsted Primary Academy (BPA), we believe that all children deserve the right to a first class education which is exciting, challenging, engaging, ambitious and boundless. We ensure to make every moment count through an enriched and innovative curriculum that extends beyond the physical classroom and school day. Every child at Bearsted Primary Academy is given the opportunity to explore and develop their strengths and to participate in new learning experiences.

Our curriculum is delivered through the International Baccalaureate (IB) Primary Years Programme (PYP) framework and the development of the IB Learner Profile attributes. This promotes collaborative and co-curricular learning opportunities and is delivered within relevant and purposeful contexts. It is built upon prior learning, and is designed to be challenging, interesting and motivational to all pupils.

So what exactly is the International Baccalaureate?

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The International Baccalaureate Primary Years Programme



The Primary Years Programme (PYP) is designed for pupils aged 3 to 12 and is one of four programmes offered by the International Baccalaureate Organisation (IBO).

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The PYP focuses on the development of the whole child as an inquirer, both in the classroom and in the world outside. It is a framework guided by six transdisciplinary themes of global significance, explored using knowledge and skills derived from six subject areas, as well as transdisciplinary skills, with a powerful emphasis on inquiry.

The PYP is flexible enough to accommodate the demands of the National Curriculum as this is the curriculum that Bearsted Primary Academy will follow. The PYP:

- Allows integrated development of cognitive and affective skills;
- Enables us to develop a curriculum appropriate to meet pupils learning needs;
- Develops autonomous and critical learners;
- Content is chosen by academies but is delivered within a concept driven curriculum to bring coherence across subjects; and
- Assessment drives learning and teaching positively.

Bearsted Primary Academy is a Candidate School* for the Primary Years Programme. This school is pursuing authorization as an IB World School. These are schools that share a common philosophy—a commitment to high quality, challenging, international education that Bearsted Primary Academy believes is important for our students.

*Only schools authorized by the IB Organization can offer any of its four academic programmes: the Primary Years Programme (PYP), the Middle Years Programme (MYP), the Diploma Programme, or the Career-related Programme (CP). In Early Years we work hard to ensure our pupils enter a safe, stimulating and nurturing environment, where children feel cared for and encouraged to achieve their full potential - no matter what their starting point.

We believe that Early Years education is fundamental to igniting a love and excitement for learning - it should be natural, fluid and inspiring for our children. We encourage children to be independent and to be involved in shaping their own learning and taking responsibility for it. Using the Curiosity Approach wqwwe teach through authentic and play-based activities - both in the indoor and outdoor spaces.

On a typical day our children are welcomed by their teacher at 8:30am - ready for an exciting day of adventures! Our school day involves a balance of carefully planned learning opportunities, alongside more independent play-based inquiries. Discovery time features heavily for our children - a time where they have the freedom to direct their learning and to discover the endless possibilities of the world around them. By using the International Baccalaureate Primary Years Programme as a framework to deliver learning, we can ensure that our children are global learners who make connections not only within their own learning, but also connect to the greater world in which they live in. Alongside the freedom of discovery, the children have daily phonics and maths teaching times.

Phonics at Bearsted follows the Letters and Sounds Programme. This whole class teaching time is designed to be fun and engaging for our children - allowing them time and space to learn the key sounds in an active way - which will then build them up to be confident and competent readers and writers. Reading is an important part of your child's reception journey - as this is the year where reading comes alive for the very first time! At Bearsted we believe that high quality phonics teaching allows a true excitement of reading to be ignited. Children are empowered through their learning to discover that they can read - it is a truly magical moment that we are so proud to share in!

Another key part of the curriculum for our Reception children is our Maths mastery approach. Maths sessions are taught daily and are followed by opportunities for our children to put in place what they have learnt. We believe that Maths needs to be active and relevant in order for our children to become mathematically confident. We encourage the use of natural objects and loose parts in aiding our young learners to make sense of number and shape in the world around them, as well as the more traditional maths resources. Our learners are challenged to dive deeper into their understanding of number - ensuring a secure foundation for them to build upon as they move through school.

Our school day finishes at 3.00pm, when parents are welcomed onto the school site to collect their children. To support those families who may need additional child care, Wrap Around Care is available before and after school from 7:30am until 6:00pm. Here, children are able to have breakfast and tea as well as engage in a range of activities and games alongside their friends.

The Learner Profile is at the heart of our curriculum and is integrated through every aspect of the curriculum, so that pupils have the opportunity to develop their personal and social attributes on a daily basis.

- Principled


